

"THREE CRUCIFIXIONS and THREE DIFFERENT RESPONSES"

(Luke 23:32-46)

Note: The day that Jesus died on Calvary, there were **{three}** crucifixions!
(Matthew 27:38 / John 19:18)

I. THE **{CRIMINAL}** ON THE LEFT

**Luke 23:32-33 * Luke 23:39-41 *John 19:31-34 *Mark 15:39*

Note: This criminal's death demonstrates the **{grace}** of God, but the **{free-will}** of man!

II. THE **{CHRIST}** IN THE MIDDLE

**Luke 23:35-37 *John 10:18 *John 19:10-11 *Luke 22:41-44*
**Romans 5:8 *Isaiah 53:5-6 *Luke 23:44-47 *Hebrews 9:24-26*

1. His death was **{voluntary}**.
2. His death was **{vicarious}**.
3. His death was **{victorious}**.

III. THE **{CRIMINAL}** ON THE RIGHT

**Matthew 27:44 *Mark 15:27-28 *Mark 15:29-32 *Luke 23:43*
**Luke 23:40-42 *Romans 10:9 *Romans 10:13 *Romans 15:4*

1. His salvation was **{immediate}**.
2. His salvation is **{illustrative}**.
3. His salvation is **{inspiring}**.
