

Sermon Notes March 2, 2008

“HAVE YOU BEEN TO CALVARY?” (Revelation 14:6)

Introduction: In the Old Testament God wanted His people to **{REMEMBER}** certain events annually (Exodus 12:14). In the New Testament God commands His people to observe the **{LORD'S SUPPER}** (I Corinthians 11:23-25) as a regular memorial. Easter is an annual reminder of something very important to God: “THE **{ETERNAL}** PLAN OF SALVATION!”

I. EASTER WAS **{CONCEIVED}** IN THE OMNISCIENCE OF GOD.

*I Peter 1:18-20 *Revelation 13:8 *Revelation 14:6 *II Timothy 1:9 *Ephesians 1:4

II. EASTER WAS **{CONCEALED}** IN MYSTERY IN OLD TESTAMENT.

*John 5:39 *Luke 24:44-47 *Hebrews 9:7-12 & 9:24 *I Corinthians 2:7-8

III. EASTER WAS **{CONFESSED}** BY JESUS.

*Galatians 4:4-6 *John 3:13-17 *John 12:27 *John 19:10-11 *Luke 24:25-27

IV. EASTER WAS THE **{COMPLETION}** OF GOD'S ETERNAL PLAN OF SALVATION.

*Matthew 26:39 *John 19:28-30 *Acts 2:22-24

Conclusion: God has only **{ONE}** plan of salvation! He wants all to receive it (I Timothy 2:3-6). But, He wants all who believe it to never forget it (Luke 22:19).
