“DO I LOVE GOD?”
(Ephesians 6:24)

Introduction: There is a man in the Bible whose name means “**{LOVER}** of God” (Luke 1:3 & Acts 1:1). Could the Holy Spirit say the same about **{YOU/ME}**? Jesus said “the greatest commandment is to **{LOVE}** God!” (Mark 12:28-30) Is it possible to “love God **INSINCERELY}**? (Ephesians 6:24) We love to hear about God loving us, but God wants us to **LOVE HIM ALSO!**

I. A LOVER OF GOD KEEPS HIS {COMMANDMENTS}

Example: **{JOSEPH}**

II. A LOVER OF GOD {SHARES/SERVES} HIM

*John 21:14-17 *Hebrews 6:10 *Acts 21:13

Example: **{PAUL}**

III. A LOVER OF GOD ENJOYS SPENDING {TIME} WITH HIM

*Psalm 42:1-2 *Psalm 84:2 *Psalm 84:10 *Psalm 122:1 *Luke 10:38-42
*John 12:3 *John 20:11-18

Examples: **{DAVID}** and **{MARY}**

Conclusion: Let each one of us ask sincerely: “Do my **{ACTIONS}** demonstrate that I am in love with God?”
