## April 27, 2008

**“WHAT HAVE YOU COMMITTED UNTO THE LORD?”**  
(II Timothy 1:12)

**Introduction:** Is there something you have “committed to the Lord”? Is there some thing you need to “commit to Jesus”? {SOMETHING PAINFUL}, {A PERSONAL DESIRE}, {A SHAMEFUL DEED}, {A VISION}, {A HUMANLY IMPOSSIBLE SITUATION} ????  
What happens when you “commit” something to the Lord?

### I. IT IS {PERSONAL}.

\*II Timothy 1:12 \*I Peter 5:6-7 \*Matthew 11:28-29 \*Psalm 23:1

**Note:** No one can {DO IT FOR YOU}!

### II. IT IS {PEACEFUL}!

\*II Timothy 1:12 \*Philippians 4:6-7 \*Romans 4:20-21 \*Luke 6:37

**Note:** The Greek word “committed” means: “DEPOSIT IN ANOTHER ACCOUNT”.

### III. IT IS {POWERFUL}!

\*II Timothy 1:12 \*Ephesians 3:20 \*Proverbs 10:28 \*Habakkuk 2:3  
\*Micah 7:18-20 \*Matthew 18:18-19 \*I John 5:14-15

**Note:** The basis of this power and peace is “{FAITH} in God”! (Hebrews 11:1)

### IV. IT IS {PATIENT}!

\*II Timothy 1:12 \*Galatians 6:9 \*Psalm 37:5 \*Hebrews 10:35-36

**Conclusion:** The most important possession you can “commit” to Jesus is {YOUR HOPE OF ETERNAL LIFE IN HEAVEN}! (I Peter 1:3-5 & I John 4:17-18) What do you need to “commit to the Lord” right now?
