**“THE BIBLE’S DESCRIPTION OF A VIRTUOUS WOMAN”**  
**(Proverbs 31:10-31)**

**Introduction:** Ladies, if you could choose only one, which of these would you choose:

a) Beauty; b) Promotion; c) Virtue? Men, if you could only have one of these qualities in a wife, which would you choose? As a parent, which of these are you making the most emphasis in your parenting? (Proverbs 31:30) Our text clearly describes a virtuous woman!

**Note:** It is very significant that this description was given by a {WOMAN} (Proverbs 31:1-2). It was written by a {MOTHER} to help her son find a virtuous wife (Proverbs 31:10).

I. **AN {ASSET}**

II. **TRUSTWORTHY** (loyal)

III. **SHE IS {DILIGENT}**

\*Proverbs 31:13 \*Proverbs 31:15 \*Proverbs 31:17-18 \*Proverbs 31:27b

**Note:** This virtuous woman fulfills many {ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES!}!

IV. **SHE IS A {PLANNER}** (organized)

\*Proverbs 31:14 \*Proverbs 31:21-22 \*Proverbs 31:27

V. **SHE IS {WISE}**

\*Proverbs 31:16 \*Proverbs 31:26 \*Proverbs 2:6

VI. **SHE IS {CONFIDENT}**

\*Proverbs 31:18 \*Philippians 4:13

VII. **SHE IS {COMPASSIONATE}**

\*Proverbs 31:15 \*Proverbs 31:20 \*Proverbs 31:26 \*Proverbs 21:19

VIII. **SHE IS {RESPECTED}**

\*Proverbs 31:28-31 \*Proverbs 22:1 \*Ruth 3:10-11 \*II Timothy 1:5

**Conclusion:** Women, what do people think about you when they are in your presence? Proverbs 31:25 would be a worthy goal.
