**\*\*\* What do you think when you hear “a man of God”? These are not {perfect; sinless; nor super humans; they are not all ministers} (Jeremiah 5:5a).**

**I. ELISHA WAS BOLD & AUDACIOUS IN HIS {PRAYERS}**

**\* II Kings 2:9-10      \*II Kings 2:19-22      \*II Kings 4:14-17      \*II Kings 4:32-36**

**\*James 5:16b-18      \*Jeremiah 33:3**

**Note: Remember the word “MAN”!**

**II. ELISHA HAD GREAT {FAITH} IN GOD**

**\*II Kings 4:1-7      \*II Kings 6:14-18      \*II Kings 2:23-24**

**Note: Elisha was not {PERFECT}! Neither was Moses, David, or Elijah! \*II Kings 4:42-44**

**III. ELISHA BELIEVED THE {WORDS} of GOD**

**\*II Kings 3:11-12      \*II Kings 3:16-18      \*II Kings 8:7-13  
\*II Timothy 3:16-17      \*Psalm 119:133**

**Note: Elisha could be a man of {COMPASSION}.**

**IV. ELISHA WAS POWERFUL INFLUENCE AFTER HIS {DEATH}**

**\*II Kings 13:20-21      \*Revelation 14:13      \*Proverbs 10:7a      \*Proverbs 17:6**
