How Many Times Can One Person Die? (I Corinthians 15:31)

Introduction: Our title may seem {UNUSUAL} and the answer may seem {OBVIOUS}, but you may be surprised by the Bible's answer? (Job 14:14)

I. THE BIBLE SPEAKS OF {PHYSICAL} DEATH.

*Hebrews 9:27 *Ecclesiastes 3:2 *Job 14:5 *Proverbs 27:1 *Luke 12:16-21
*I Peter 3:18 *John 11:25-26 *Romans 8:38-39 *Philippians 1:21-23

NOTE: Physical death does {NOT} mean the end of a person's existence!

II. THE BIBLE SPEAKS OF {SPIRITUAL} DEATH.

*Revelation 20:5-6 *Revelation 20:11-15 *Revelation 21:8 *Matthew 10:28
*Luke 16:22-26 *Matthew 25:41 *Matthew 25:46

NOTE: Spiritual death does {NOT} mean the end of a person's existence! Both {HEAVEN} and {HELL} are real and eternal.

III. THE BIBLE SPEAKS OF {DAILY} DEATH.

*I Corinthians 15:31 *II Corinthians 11:23 *Luke 9:23 *Galatians 2:20
*Romans 6:11 *Galatians 5:16-17 *II Corinthians 10:3-4

NOTE: This is called "Death to {SELF}". It must happen {REPEATEDLY/DAILY}.

Conclusion: The Bible says: "There shall be no more death" in {HEAVEN} (Revelation 21:4). Not: physical, spiritual, or emotional (Psalm 16:11 & Revelation 21:27)!
