“WHEN YOU CAN NOT TAKE ANY MORE...”

(I Corinthians 10:13)

Introduction: What should a believer do, when they really feel {“THEY CAN NOT TAKE ANY MORE”}? There are {TWO} wrong responses, but there are {THREE} correct responses. (I Corinthians 10:12-13 & I Peter 5:5-7)

I. REMEMBER HIS {PROMISES}

*I Corinthians 10:13 *Hebrews 13:5-6 *Isaiah 43:2 *Psalm 23:4

*Lamentations 3:22-23 *Hebrews 6:18 *Psalm 121:1-8 *Psalm 119:49-50

Note: Our hope is based upon the {FAITHFULNESS} of God!

II. REMEMBER HIS {POWER}

*I Corinthians 10:13 *Matthew 28:18 *Ephesians 1:19-22

*Daniel 3:22-25 *Daniel 6:16-23 *Isaiah 59:19

Note: Our peace is based upon the {ATTRIBUTES/CHARACTER} of God!

III. REMEMBER HIS {PROVIDENCE} (PROVISIONS)

*I Corinthians 10:13 *II Peter 2:6-9 *Acts 12:5-11

*Exodus 9:23-26 *Exodus 11:5-7 *Exodus 14:19-20

Note: There is a difference in “a way of escape” {GOD} makes and we make!

Conclusion: These apply to {EVERY} test we have in the Christian life.
