"Facts About Faith" (Matthew 8:5-13)

Introduction: One of the great themes of the Bible is { FAITH}(Hebrews 11:6). One of the greatest possessions of life is { FAITH}(John 11:40). Our message today teaches several facts about faith (I Corinthians 13:13).

I. THERE ARE DIFFERENT {LEVELS} OF FAITH.

Scriptures

Some have {GREAT} faith.
(Matthew 8:10-13 & Matthew 15:28)

Some have {WEAK} faith.
(Matthew 6:30-32; 8:25-26; & 14:31)

Some have {NO} faith.
(Matthew 13:58; Hebrews 3:16-19; Romans 10:16;
& Acts 26:26-28)

II. THERE ARE DIFFERENT {SOURCES} OF FAITH.

Scriptures

It is not {NATURAL}.
(Matthew 8:10; II Timothy 1:5; & Hebrews 11:31)

It can {INCREASE}.
(Luke 17:5; Romans 10:17; Galatians 5:22; Judges
7:3; Mark 9:24; & Ephesians 6:16)

III. THERE ARE DIFFERENT { RESULTS} OF FAITH.

Scriptures

Sometimes the results are {IMMEDIATE}.
(Matthew 8:13)

Sometimes the results are {LATER}.
(Hebrews 10:36-38)

Sometimes the results are {ETERNAL}.
(Hebrews 11:32-40)

Conclusion: God gives some faith to { ALL} (Romans 12:3 & Ephesians 2:8).
