

# Sermon Notes

## September 23, 2007

### “THE PEACE OF GOD” (Psalm 29:11)

Introduction: One of God’s blessings is {PEACE} (Psalm 29:11). He is able to give {US PEACE} (Proverbs 16:7). We are told to pray for {PEACE} (Psalm 122:6-8).

#### I. PEACE ORIGINATES IN THE {SPIRIT}.

\*John 16:33    \*Romans 15:33    \*Romans 5:1    \*John 14:27    \*Galatians 5:22

Note: Our spiritual status dynamically affects our level of {PEACE}! (Isaiah 48:18 & Proverbs 3:2).

#### II. PEACE MUST BE ENGRAFTED IN OUR {MINDS}.

\*Isaiah 26:3-4    \*Matthew 11:28-29    \*Romans 8:6    \*II Corinthians 10:3-5

Note: This is why a believer must “renew their {MIND}”, if they desire to have constant peace (Romans 12:1-2).

#### III. PEACE MUST BE PURSUED DILIGENTLY IN THE {HEART}.

\*Philippians 4:6-8    \*Psalm 34:14    II Thessalonians 3:16    \*Psalm 4:8

Note: The heart is our {WILL}. A believer must deliberately choose to {TRUST} God before they can have God’s peace.

**Conclusion:** The peace of God requires: {FAITH}; the {WORD}; and {PRAYER}.
