“THE CHOICES WE MAKE”
(I John 5:3 & Philippians 4:13)

Introduction: One of the greatest powers is the power of {CHOICE}. Some call this {WILL} power! The Bible says that none of God’s commandments are {IMPOSSIBLE TO OBEY} (I John 5:3). The Bible also says that God {HELPS} believers to do His will and keep His commandments (Philippians 4:13 & 2:13).

IV. WE CHOOSE TO {REJOICE}

V. WE CHOOSE TO BE {SAVED}

*John 3:16-19 *Romans 10:13-17 *Ephesians 2:8 *Romans 12:3
*John 1:12 *Jeremiah 29:13
